- Any leftover fabric from either of the quilts
- Take a moment before the workshop to jot down any memories associated with each of the quilts.

I'll email you a list of prompts that will help you write your stories and capture the important detail from the life of the quiltmaker (YOU).

We'll all share the quilts we've chosen and discuss important details in them.

This will be a fun exercise for everyone.
